- Formal judging by judging panel will begin at 11:30. Kiwanis club cups will be used for chili.
- Formal judging will be condiment/topping free (no sour cream, cilantro, cheese, etc).
- People's Choice Award voting will be open from 11:30 am to 1:30 pm
- All awards will be announced and presented at 2:00 pm
- Cookers and cook teams agree they will not distribute alcoholic beverages to the public.
- Kiwanis Club will provide non-alcoholic beverage coupons to each cook team.
- There is no fee to participate as a cook team.
